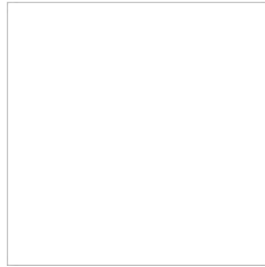
terest in joining the order and becoming a Knight. We are looking for men that want to help those in need, serve the parish and community and grow in the faith.
